

- **5-HT**<sub>1A</sub>: Involved in mood regulation, anxiety, and depression.
- 5-HT<sub>1B</sub>: Mediates vasodilation and gastrointestinal motility.
- 5-HT<sub>1D</sub>: Regulates vascular tone and platelet aggregation.
- 5-HT<sub>1E</sub>: Plays a role in cognition and memory.

- **5-HT**<sub>4</sub>: Involved in gastrointestinal motility and cognition.
- 5-HT<sub>5A</sub>: Facilitates memory formation and synaptic plasticity.
- **5-HT**<sub>5B</sub>: Supports satiety, thermoregulation, and learning.
- 5-HT<sub>6</sub>: Mediates cognition, mood, and anxiety.
- **5-HT**<sub>7</sub>: Regulates circadian rhythms, sleep, and depression.






