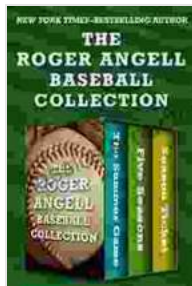

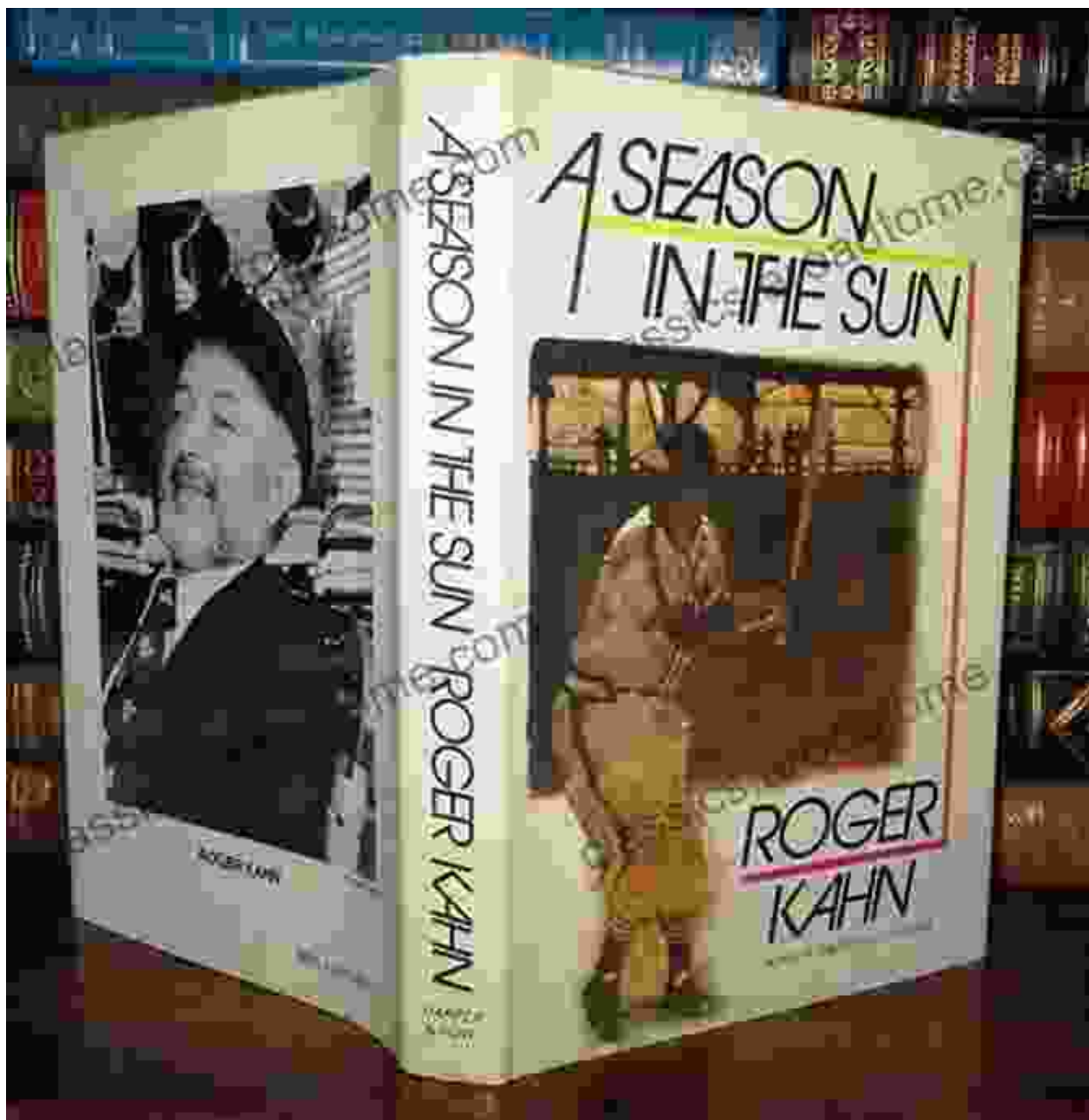
Roger Kahn is an American author and journalist. He has written over 20 books on baseball, including *The Boys of Summer*, which won the Pulitzer

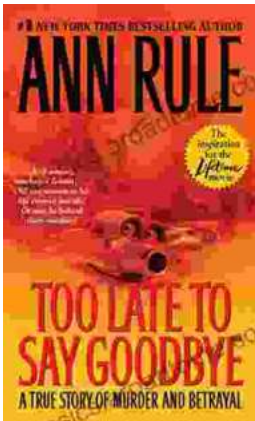

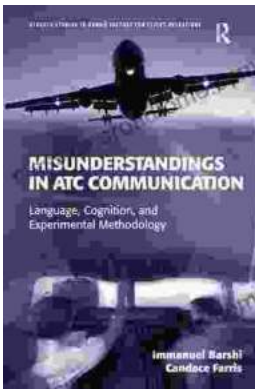
